

What do we do?

Sessions are a mixture of coaching and games. Our aim is to coach children aged 6 to 17 all aspects of the game of badminton, but above all it is about playing an exciting sport and having some fun. New players are given individual help with basic racket skills, whilst more experienced players practice shots in a group. The latter part of each session is spent playing competitive games.

There are competitions throughout the year and trophies to be won at the end of the season. The top players compete to win the coveted Gloria Hudson Rose Bowl. Those showing promise have the opportunity to join the Warwickshire County junior squad.

The sports hall has 4 courts and 24 players per session.

What will you need?

If you have a badminton racket please bring it along. If not we have a selection of good quality rackets that can be borrowed each week free of charge, including short handled ones for the younger players.

Sports clothing is best and soft-soled indoor sports shoes are safer than hard soled trainers.

Nets and shuttles are provided.

What does it cost?

The season runs from September through to May. Fees vary but are typically £20 each half-term.
